ORDER NO. 148

Amending Rule 2 of the
Rules of Administration

Rule 2 of the Rules of Administration of All Courts
shall be amended to read as follows:

Rule 2. Appointment and Compensation
of Employees - Practice of Law by
Personnel Prohibited.

A. The administrative director shall receive the same compensation as a superior court judge. The administrative director with the approval of the chief justice shall appoint and fix the compensation of such assistants and clerical employees as are necessary to enable him to exercise and perform the powers and duties vested in him.


B. The administrative director shall draw personnel rules and regulations governing all personnel employed by the Alaska Court System. No employee shall be exempt from the personnel regulations except as specifically set forth in the rules of court.

C. No employee of the Court System shall be hired without prior approval of the administrative director of the court system or his designee except that the following persons are exempt from such approval provided funds were budgeted for such a position:

1. The personal secretary of a judge;
2. Law clerks assigned to a particular court or judge;
3. The clerks of courts.

D. During his term of office or employment, neither the administrative director nor any other employee of the Alaska Court System shall engage directly or indirectly in the practice of law in any of the courts of this state.
