

IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA
ORDER NO. 1995

Rescinding SCO 1875 (Amended) that temporarily amended Civil Rule 6(a), Criminal Rule 40(a), and Appellate Rule 502(a), by providing that any filing due on a day that the court was closed for a full or partial day was deemed timely filed on the next business day; providing a transition provision.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. SCO 1875 and SCO 1875 (Amended) are rescinded. SCO 1875 (Amended) provided the following:

Civil Rule 6(a), Criminal Rule 40(a), and Appellate Rule 502(a) are amended on a temporary basis as follows:

Any filing that is due on a day that the court is closed for either a full day or a partial day will be considered timely filed if it is filed by close of business on the next regular business day. Any day the court is closed for a full weekday or partial weekday will be considered a “legal holiday” for the purposes of time computation.

2. During a transition period until January 1, 2023, any filing that is due on a Friday in December 2022 will be deemed timely filed if filed by the close of business on the next regular business day. Also, those Fridays are deemed a “legal holiday” for the purposes of time computation.
