ORDER NO. 542

Amending Paragraph (b) of Rule 84, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure relating to proof of publication in change of name proceedings.

IT IS ORDERED:

Paragraph (b) of Rule 84, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read as follows:

(b) Notice of Application. The court by order shall set a date for hearing not less than forty (40) days after the date of the order. Notice of the filing of the petition with a statement of the relief sought therein and the date of hearing thereon shall be published in a newspaper designated by the court as being the publication most likely to give appropriate notice under the circumstances. Publication of the notice shall be made once each week for 4 consecutive calendar weeks prior to the date of the hearing. In its discretion, the court by order may also require the posting of the notice at such place or places, in designated communities as may be appropriate. Proof of publication shall be made as prescribed in Rule 4(e) ~~(6)~~ (5). Proof of posting shall be made by affidavit.


