
IT IS ORDERED:


A new subparagraph (a)(3) is added to Appellate Rule 303 to provide:


(3) Cross-Petitions. When a petition is filed any other party may file and serve a cross-petition for hearing within 15 days after service of the petition. Otherwise, the provisions of this rule referring to petitions for hearing also apply to cross-petitions for hearing.




