ORDER NO. 875

Amending Criminal Rule 25(d)(5)
concerning waiver of peremptory
challenge of judge.

IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 25(d)(5) is amended to provide:

(5) Waiver. A party loses the right [HIS RIGHTS] under this rule to change a judge when the party [HE], after a reasonable opportunity to consult with counsel, agrees to the assignment of the case to the [A PARTICULAR] judge or ,knowing that the judge has been permanently assigned to the case, participates before the judge [HIM] in an omnibus hearing, any subsequent pretrial hearing, a hearing under Rule 11, or the commencement of trial. No provision of this rule shall bar a stipulation as to the judge before whom a plea of guilty or of nolo contendere shall be taken under Rule 11.
