

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 92

Amending Rule 9(a), Rules
Governing the Administration
of All Courts.

Supreme Court Order No. 90, dated July 24, 1967, amended Rule 9(a), Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts so as to provide for an increase in the amount of witness fees and of compensation for subsistence expense of witnesses.

It has now come to the attention of this court that agencies of the State of Alaska will be unable to pay any increased costs until a supplemental appropriation has been obtained from the legislature.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That Rule 9(a), Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts is again amended to read as follows:

"(a) Amount. A witness attending before any judge, magistrate, referee, master, grand jury or coroner's jury, when necessarily subpoenaed to attend or whose testimony is necessary and material to the action, shall receive \$4.00 for each day of attendance and for time necessarily occupied in traveling from his residence and returning from the place of trial or hearing. Any such witness who attends at a point so far removed from his residence as to necessarily prohibit return thereto from day to day, shall receive an additional \$9.00 per day for expenses of subsistence for each day of attendance and for each day necessarily occupied in traveling to and from such attendance."
