


9. Time is tolled in all criminal and traffic cases. Criminal Rule 45(d)(7).
10. Hearings on petitions for domestic violence, stalking orders (both ex parte and long term), and for testing/isolation/quarantine orders shall proceed.
11. Hearings on petitions for Title 47 involuntary commitment or medication orders shall proceed.
12. Hearings on temporary custody petitions in CINA and juvenile delinquency cases and CINA .087 hearings shall proceed.
13. All traffic, change of name, FED, and small claims cases and marriage ceremonies are suspended.
14. All domestic relations hearings are suspended, except litigants may seek to have hearings on emergency child custody issues.
15. All other civil case hearings are suspended, except litigants may seek to have hearings on emergency issues.
16. To the extent possible litigants and counsel shall attend hearings by video or telephone. A request to attend a civil hearing or non-jury trial in person shall be addressed to the assigned judge.
17. This Order and the suspensions will be revisited no later than 31 March 2020 as the results of the quarantines are evaluated.
18. The possible application of this Order or a variant of it to other court locations within the Third Judicial District is being evaluated.
