## IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 2037

Amending Alaska Bar Rule 53(d) to change the limits on payments from the Lawyers' Fund for Client Protection.

## IT IS ORDERED:

Bar Rule 53(d) is amended to read as follows:

## Rule 53. Consideration by the Board.

\* \* \* \*

(d) The loss to be paid to any individual claimant as the result of any dishonest act or omission in any one transaction, matter or proceeding involving any one lawyer shall not exceed the lesser of the following sums: (a) \$100,000\$50,000, or (b) 10% of the Fund at the time the award is made. The aggregate maximum amount which all claimants may recover arising from an instance or course of dishonest conduct of any one lawyer is \$200,000. The total amount to be paid to all claimants in any one year shall not exceed 50% of the total amount of the Fund as of January 1 of the calendar year in which the awards are made.
