Special Order of the Chief Justice No. 8202 directs presiding judges to strongly consider limiting or suspending misdemeanor jury trials in a district or community where the average daily case rate is greater than 20-25 per 100,000 as reported in the Daily Case Count Summary of the Alaska Department of Health and Social Services. The most recent case count for the Fairbanks North Star Borough is 34.41 cases per 100,000. The most recent case count for the YK-Delta Region is 119.18 cases per 100,000. Accordingly,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that misdemeanor trials in the Fourth Judicial District are suspended until December 1, 2020.
