**LONG-TERM ORDER
OF PROTECTION FROM
FINANCIAL ABUSE (AS 13.26.455)**

A. BACKGROUND

A petition was filed on behalf of the protected person named above to convert an existing 20-day ex parte order of protection from financial abuse to a long-term order. The court makes the following findings and order based on:
