## Transfer of Cases from Not Assigned 3PA-03 to Judge Patrick J. McKay Jr.

- 1. Effective **June 9, 2025**, all open court cases currently assigned to Not Assigned 3PA-03 will be reassigned to Judge Patrick J. McKay Jr.
- 2. Notice of peremptory disqualification for cases reassigned to Judge Patrick J. McKay Jr. under this order must be filed on or before June 2, 2025, except as provided by Civil Rule 42(c)(4) and Criminal Rule 25(d)(5). Each party is allowed one peremptory change of judge during the life of a case. This administrative order does not grant any party an additional right to peremptorily challenge a judge.
- 3. It is the responsibility of all Third District law firms and attorneys to notify any associate counsel or opposing counsel who are outside the Third Judicial District or the State of Alaska of the foregoing reassignments for purposes of peremptory challenges.
