You are invited to register for the National Center for State Courts (NCSC) written examination for court interpreters. The examination will be administered by the Alaska Court System.

- Date of the Exam:** Friday, September 3, 2021
- Time:** Exam begins at 9:30am.
All candidates must be present and ready to begin the exam at 9:15 a.m.
- Location:** Snowden Administration Building
820 W. 4th Avenue, Anchorage, AK.
- Registration:** Interpreter candidates must register with Stefanie Burich by Sunday, August 15, 2021.
- Exam Fee:** None

You are eligible to take the written exam because you have successfully completed the Alaska Court System's court-specific interpreter online training class.

Once you submit your registration, you will receive more information about what to expect on exam day such as:

- when to arrive at the testing site;
- what you may and may not bring to the exam room; and
- identification documents required.

The NCSC written examination is in English and has 135 multiple-choice questions covering general English proficiency, court-related terms and usage, and ethics/professional conduct required of court interpreters.
