Amending Alaska Bar Rule 3 concerning late applications for the bar examination.

IT IS ORDERED:


1. Section 3 of Alaska Bar Rule 3 is amended to provide:


Section 3. An application shall be filed not later than May 1 for the July bar examination and not later than December 1 for the February bar examination. In the event that an application is filed late, an additional late filing fee of \$25 shall be paid if filed not later than fourteen days after the last day for filing a timely application, and a late filing fee of \$100 shall be paid if filed thereafter; provided, however, no application shall be accepted for late filing unless such application is filed at the office of the Alaska Bar Association not later than June 15 for the July bar examination and January 15 for the February bar examination. The Executive Director may, for good cause, accept applications for late filing after the June 15 and January 15 deadlines. A total late filing fee of \$125.00 shall be paid for applications accepted after June 15 and January 15.




