Establishing Barrow as Seat  
of a District Court and  
Increasing the Number of  
District Judges in the  
Second Judicial District

WHEREAS it appears that the volume and importance of  
judicial business at Barrow, Second Judicial District, Alaska,  
has so increased that the full time judicial services of a  
district judge are required in this location,

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 31 (a), Rules Governing the Administration of All  
Courts be amended as follows:

In line 4 of said subdivision (a), opposite the  
words "Second Judicial District", strike the  
figure "1" and substitute the figure "2".

Rule 32 (a), Rules Governing the Administration of All  
Courts be amended as follows:

In paragraph (2) of said subdivision (a)  
after the word "Nome" add the words "and  
Barrow".
