Amending Rule 17 (a), Rules
of Administration and Rule
86 (i), Civil Rules

IT IS ORDERED:

The Rules Governing the Administration of All Courts
and the Rules of Civil Procedure are amended as set out
below:

Rule 17 (a), Rules Governing the Administration of
All Courts.

Is amended by deleting in line 2 of said subdivision
the figure: "\$10.00" and substituting therefore the
figure: "\$21.00."

Rule 86 (i), Rules of Civil Procedure. Is amended
to read as follows:

(i) Controverting Answer. The plaintiff or the
prisoner may, in a reply or at the hearing, contro-
vert the answer under oath, to show either that the
restraint of the prisoner was unlawful, or that he
is entitled to his discharge or other appropriate
remedy.
