ORDER NO. 1073

Amending Alaska Bar Rule 48(b)  
concerning the Lawyers' Fund for  
Client Protection Committee.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Bar Rule 48(b) is amended to provide:

(b) A quorum at any meeting of the Committee shall be three members. A member participating in Committee proceedings by telephone is present for all purposes, including purposes of a quorum. [NO ACTION SHALL BE TAKEN BY THE COMMITTEE IN] In the absence of a quorum[; BUT AT ANY SUCH MEETING ANY] a matter may be considered by the members present, [WITHOUT THE TAKING OF ANY] but no action may be taken with respect thereto. The vote of a majority of the members present and voting at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall constitute the action of the Committee.
