ORDER NO. 1098

Amending Civil Rule 74
concerning return of exhibits.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Civil Rule 74(g)(1) and (2) are amended to provide:

(g) Records After Final Determination

(1) After final judgment and after the time has passed for taking an appeal or filing a petition for review, all models, diagrams, exhibits and depositions heretofore or hereafter filed in any action, shall be returned to the submitting party [OR PERSON TO WHOM THEY BELONG], without the necessity of filing any copies thereof.

(2) After final judgment, and upon the filing of a stipulation waiving and abandoning the right to appeal, to petition for review, or to move for a new trial, all such models, diagrams, exhibits and depositions may be withdrawn from the clerk's office by the submitting party [OR PERSONS TO WHOM THE SAME BELONG], without the necessity of filing any copies thereof.
