1. Administrative Rule 9(e)(6) is amended to read:

(e) **Miscellaneous Fees in the Superior Court
and the District Court:**

. . . .

(6) For service of process:

(i) By certified mail (postage
provided by party) \$ 4.00

(ii) By registered mail (postage
provided by party) \$10.00

[(iii) SERVICE OF SUMMONS AND
COMPLAINT AND NOTICES TO
JUDGMENT DEBTORS BY CERTIFIED
MAIL IN SMALL CLAIMS ACTIONS
(POSTAGE PROVIDED BY COURT) \$10.00]

A party requesting service of process by
certified or registered mail must supply
an addressed envelope, adequate postage,
and appropriate postal forms. [EXCEPT FOR
SERVICE OF SUMMONS AND COMPLAINT AND
NOTICES TO JUDGMENT DEBTORS IN SMALL
CLAIMS ACTIONS, NECESSARY POSTAGE, AN
ADDRESSED ENVELOPE FOR MAILING, AND
COMPLETED POSTAL FORMS FOR THE DELIVERY
