Amending Appellate Rule 210(c)
concerning excerpts of record.

IT IS ORDERED:

Subparagraph (4) of Appellate Rule 210(c) is amended to read:

(4) *Form, Filing and Service.* Each party's excerpt of record shall be bound separately from the party's brief and shall contain a table of contents at the beginning of the first volume. The excerpt and the table of contents shall be in the form specified in the Clerk's Instructions for Preparation of Excerpts published in these rules. One copy of the excerpt shall be filed and served with the party's original brief. Six copies of the excerpt shall be filed with the bound copies of the brief, and one copy shall be served on counsel for each party separately represented. ~~unless~~ The appellate court may specify the filing or service of a different number of copies than required by this rule.
