

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 141

Amending Rule 13, Rules
Governing the Administra-
tion of all Courts.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Rule 13 of the Rules Governing the Administration of all Courts shall be amended to read as follows:

Rule 13. Exemptions from Payment of Filing Fees.

(a) The state, or any office or agency thereof, shall be exempt from payment of any filing fees in any court of the state. Other persons may be granted an exemption by the court as provided in subdivision (b) of this Rule.

(b) A person represented by an attorney furnished to him by an organization authorized to provide legal services to indigents, or any other person who requests an exemption of filing fees, must first file an indigency statement on a form prescribed by the Administrative Director of Courts. In the case of a person represented by an attorney furnished to him by an organization authorized to provide legal service to indigents, that organization shall also file, when appropriate, attorney rejection letters with the Court.
