IT IS ORDERED:

Criminal Rule 12 is amended to read as follows:

**Rule 12. Pleadings and Motions Before Trial — Defenses
and Objections.**

* * * *

(c) **Pretrial Motion Date.** ~~In misdemeanor cases, All~~ pretrial motions listed in Rule 12(b) must be filed within ~~45~~20 days after the defendant's arraignment. ~~In felony cases, all pretrial motions listed in Rule 12(b) must be filed within 45 days after the defendant's arraignment.~~ The court may vary these times for good cause shown.
