Amending Rule 74,
Rules of Civil Procedure

IT IS ORDERED:

Alaska Rule of Civil Procedure 74(g) is hereby amended
to read as follows:

(g) Records After Final Determination.


(1) After final judgment and after the time has passed for taking an appeal or filing a petition for review, all models, diagrams, exhibits, and depositions heretofore or hereafter filed in any action, shall be returned to the party or person to whom they belong, without the necessity of filing any copies thereof.


(2) After final judgment, and upon the filing of a stipulation waiving and abandoning the right to appeal, to petition for review, or to move for a new trial, all such models, diagrams, exhibits and depositions may be withdrawn from the clerk's office by the party or persons to whom the same belong, without the necessity of filing any copies thereof.

(3) If such models, diagrams, exhibits and depositions are not so returned or withdrawn as above indicated, the clerk shall destroy the same or make such other disposition of them as the court may approve.

(4) Nothing contained in this subdivision (g) of this rule shall prevent the court, for special reasons and after notice, from making such other order with respect to any files, models, exhibits and depositions as it may deem advisable.


