

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 166

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 48 of the Rules of Administration is adopted to read as follows:

Rule 48. Vacation Leave and Judicial Leave.

(a) Vacation Leave. Each superior and district court in each judicial district of the State of Alaska shall adopt leave rules for judges for that district which permit the orderly transaction of business and insure the availability of judicial personnel. Such rules shall be transmitted to the chief justice of the Alaska Court System and upon his approval shall constitute the leave rules for that court. The supreme court shall promulgate similar rules for the supreme court.

(b) Judicial Leave. Each judge or justice shall be permitted to attend conferences, seminars or schools which further his legal education or professional qualifications with the permission of the presiding judge of his court and the chief justice of the supreme court. Travel expenses and per diem as set forth in Rules of Administration 24, 28 and 35 may be provided. Judicial leave authorized for such purpose shall not be counted as vacation leave.
