Appellate Rule 602. Time-Venue-Notice-Bonds.

(j) Filing and Service of Documents. Papers may be filed either by delivering them or mailing them to the clerk of the superior court at the court location where the appeal is filed, unless otherwise ordered. Papers mailed to the superior court will be deemed filed on the date of receipt by the clerk. Papers filed or served in the appeal must be served on all parties, except appellees who have elected not to participate in the action.
