ORDER NO. 179

Amending Rule 48 of the  
Rules of Administration

IT IS ORDERED:

Section (a) of Rule 48 of the Rules of Administration is amended by deleting the second full paragraph of Section (a) and substituting the following:

Each District Court judge and each magistrate serving the state on a full-time basis shall be entitled to annual vacation in accordance with and limited by the provisions of AS 39.20.200-.330. Such vacation shall be taken at the time or times prescribed by the presiding judge of his or her judicial district. Each District Court judge and each full-time magistrate shall be allowed sick leave in accordance and limited by the provisions of AS 39.20.200-.330. Each magistrate serving the state on less than a full-time basis shall be entitled to an annual vacation of not more than fifteen (15) working days. It shall be taken at such time or times as may be prescribed by the presiding Superior Court judge for his or her judicial district. Vacation time not taken in any calendar year may not be accumulated. Each part-time magistrate shall be entitled to ten (10) days' sick leave with respect to illness necessitating absence from his or her judicial duties, which sick leave shall not be charged against his or her vacation time. Sick leave time not taken in any calendar year may not be accumulated.
