IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA ORDER NO. 1808

Amending Alaska Bar Rule 5(1)(a)(2) to require a passing MPRE score at an examination not more than eight years prior to an Alaska application for admission

IT IS ORDERED:

Alaska Bar Rule 5, Section 1 is amended as follows:

Rule 5. Requirements for Admission to the Practice of Law.

Section 1. (a) To be admitted to the practice of law in Alaska, an applicant must:

- (1) pass the bar examination prescribed pursuant to Rule 4 or be excused from taking the bar examination under Rule 2, Section 2;
- (2) pass the Multistate Professional Responsibility Examination by obtaining a scaled score of 80 at an examination taken not more than eight years prior to the applicant's Alaska application for admission;
