

THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 251

Amending Rule 67, Rules
of Civil Procedure.

IT IS ORDERED:

Rule 67(b), Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

(b) In any action where payment of moneys for purposes of child support is ordered, payment shall be made to the child support enforcement agency, unless another payment method is ordered by the court for cause. The court shall accept reasonable agreements as to method of payment. When payment is to be made to the agency, an order shall be entered which shall contain the following:

(1) The names of the parties and of the children for whom support payments are ordered; the home addresses of the parties together with their mailing addresses, if different from their home addresses; and the name and address of the employer, if any, of the party ordered to make child support payments.

(2) A provision directing each party to inform the child support enforcement agency, in writing, of any change in his or her residence or mailing address within five days after any such change. The order shall also state the address of the agency.

(3) A provision directing transmittal of a copy of the order to each party to the action and to the agency.




