ORDER NO. 252

Adding Rule 90.1, Rules of
Civil Procedure, and Amending
Rule 84, Rules of Civil
Procedure.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. The Rules of Civil Procedure are amended by adding Rule 90.1 to read:

RULE 90.1 DISSOLUTION OF MARRIAGE.

(a) Commencement of Action. An action for dissolution of marriage under AS 9.55.231-.237 shall be commenced by the filing of a petition in the superior court containing the recitations required by statute.

(b) Verification. The petition shall be signed and verified by both petitioners if the petition is filed by husband and wife together or by the petitioner filing the action if filed separately.

(c) Form of Petition. The petition may be filed on forms approved by the supreme court. Information may be inserted on the forms in legible handwriting.

2. Rule 84, Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended by adding paragraph (d) to read:

(d) Applicability. This rule shall not apply to restoration of a prior name sought in a complaint for divorce or in a petition for dissolution of marriage.


