ORDER NO. 441

Amending Civil Rule 76(a),
relating to briefs in the
Superior Court

IT IS ORDERED:

Civil Rule 76(a) is amended to read as follows:

(a) Form in General. All pleadings, motions, affidavits, memoranda, instructions and other papers and documents, including exhibits thereto, presented for filing with the clerk or intended for use of the judge, (1) shall be upon legal size white paper of good quality, of at least sixteen pound weight, and not onionskin except where ripple finish or other opaque paper is used, in which event the weight shall be at least thirteen pound; (2) shall be either in original clear and legible typewriting with black ribbon, or in clear and legible printing; and (3) shall be in double-spaced typewriting or printing, except that quotations shall be single-spaced and indented.






