

IN THE SUPREME COURT OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 471

Two-part Order Amending Alaska Civil Rule 5(e) and Alaska Criminal Rule 44(d), Relating to the Place of Filing of Documents.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. Paragraph (e) of Rule 5, Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure, is amended to read:

(c) Filing With the Court Defined. The filing of pleadings and other papers with the court as required by these rules shall be made by filing them with the clerk of the court at the court location where the case is filed unless otherwise directed by the court, except that the judge may permit the papers to be filed with him, in which event he shall note thereon the filing date and forthwith transmit them to the office of the clerk.

2. Paragraph (d) of Rule 44, Alaska Rules of Criminal Procedure, is amended to read:

(d) Filing. Papers required to be served shall be filed with the [COURT] clerk at the court location where the case is filed unless otherwise directed by the court. Papers shall be filed in the manner provided in the [CIVIL ACTIONS] Alaska Rules of Civil Procedure.
