Amending District Court Civil
Rule 4 concerning assignment
and hearing of cases

IT IS ORDERED:

District Court Civil Rule 4 is amended to provide:

The assignment and calendaring of cases in the district [MAGISTRATE'S] court shall be as set forth in Civil Rule 40(a), or by such procedures established by the presiding judge [MAGISTRATE] as will cause all cases to be regularly reviewed for placement on the trial calendar for dismissal for want of prosecution, or other appropriate disposition.
