Amending Rule 3,  
Rules of Criminal Procedure

IT IS ORDERED:

That the Rules of Criminal Procedure are amended  
as set out below:

Rule 3(a), Rules of Criminal Procedure: Is amended to read  
as follows:

(a) The complaint is a written statement of  
the essential facts constituting the offense  
charged. It shall be made upon oath before any  
magistrate, except that complaints for traffic  
violations or for misdemeanors where the arrest  
has been made without the necessity of a warrant,  
may be signed before any person authorized by law  
to administer oaths.
