ORDER NO. 88

Rescinding Rule 1(j), Magistrate  
Rules of Criminal Procedure, and  
Repromulgating Same

IT IS ORDERED:

That subdivision (j) of Rule 1, Magistrate Rules of Criminal Procedure, as amended by Supreme Court Order No. 86 effective September 15, 1966, is hereby rescinded and is hereby repromulgated to read as follows:

(j) Rules Inapplicable in Misdemeanor Cases.  
In a misdemeanor case the provisions of the following Rules of Criminal Procedure shall not apply:

Rule 5, relating to preliminary examination,

Rule 32(c), relating to pre-sentence investigation,

Rule 30, relating to instructions,

Rules 39(b) and 15(c), with respect to appointment of counsel for indigent defendants, and

Rule 50(a), relating to written appearance and withdrawal of counsel.
