

IN THE SUPREME COURT FOR THE STATE OF ALASKA

ORDER NO. 983

Amending CINA Rule 19(a) and
Delinquency Rule 25(a)
concerning the time limit to
request an evidentiary hearing
for annual review.

IT IS ORDERED:

1. CINA Rule 19(a) is amended to provide:

(a) Annual Review. The court shall review its disposition order annually. The review will take place without a hearing on the basis of written reports, statements and affidavits unless an evidentiary hearing is requested by a party or ordered by the court on its own motion. The Department shall serve the parties with copies of the reports, statements and affidavits submitted to the court for its annual review together with a notice of their right to submit statements, affidavits or other evidence to the court and notice of their right to request an evidentiary hearing within 20 days of service.

2. Delinquency Rule 25(a) is amended to provide:

(a) Annual Review. The court shall review its disposition order annually. The review will take place without a hearing on the basis of written reports and any statements or affidavits which accompany the reports unless a hearing is requested by a party or ordered by the court on its own motion. The Department shall serve the parties with copies of reports,




statements and affidavits submitted to the court for annual review together with a notice of the parties' right to submit statements, affidavits or other evidence to the court and a notice of their right to request a hearing within 20 days of service.


